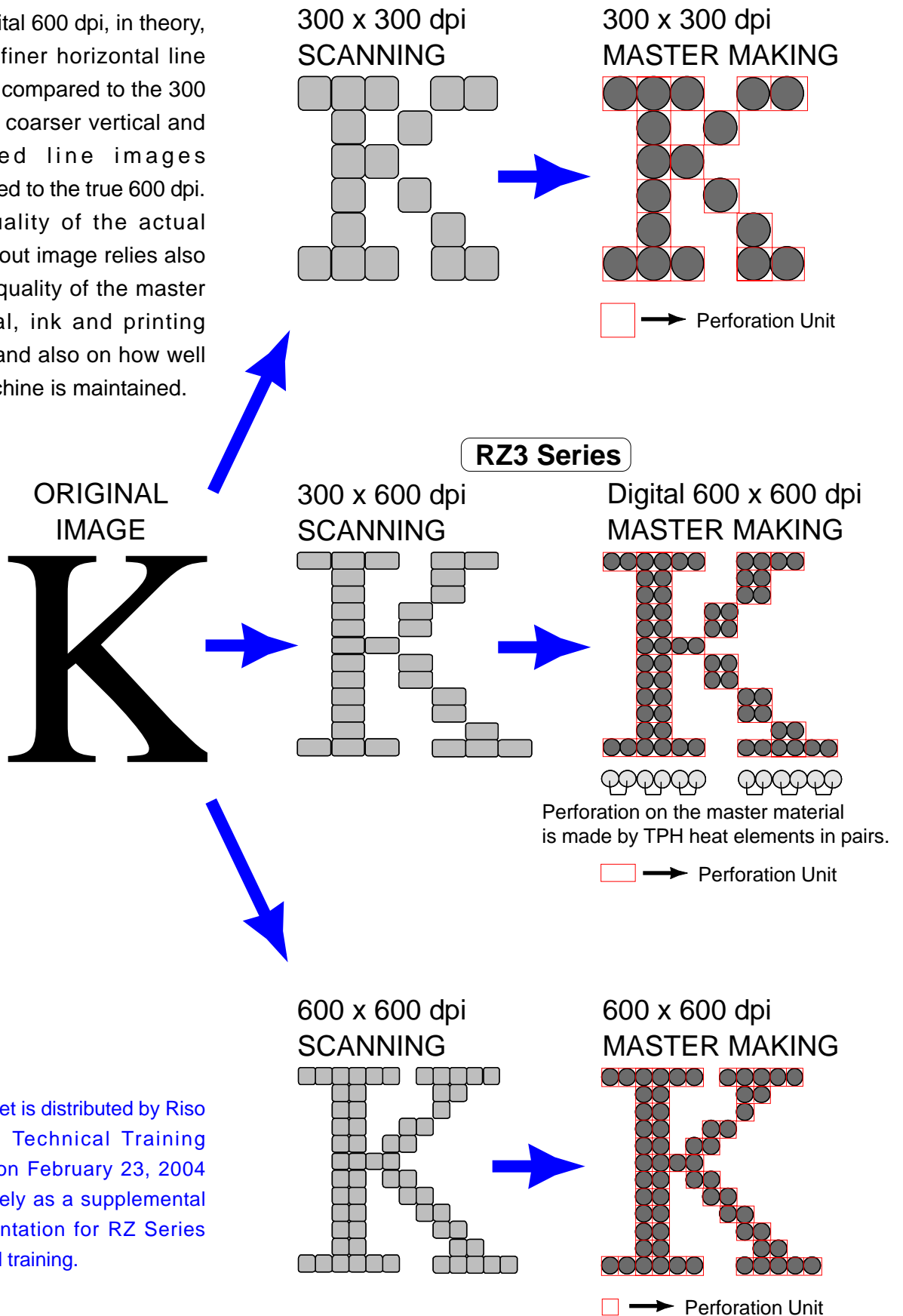


Brief view of Digital 600 dpi on RZ3 Series

Comparison between 300 dpi, digital 600 dpi (RZ3 series), and true 600 dpi.

The digital 600 dpi, in theory, makes finer horizontal line images compared to the 300 dpi, but coarser vertical and inclined line images compared to the true 600 dpi. The quality of the actual printed out image relies also on the quality of the master material, ink and printing paper, and also on how well the machine is maintained.
